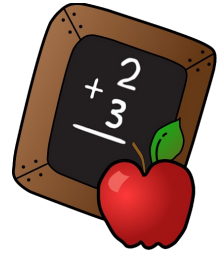

Childhood Cancer Awareness

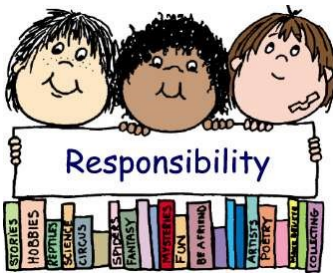
